

Tips for the best video

Are you wondering how to get started on the video for your MASAA application? Here are a few tips from faculty about what they are looking for in a video submission:

- **Take some time to plan your answers.** Read [Gonzaga's Mission Statement](#) when preparing to answer the two questions. Practice what you are going to say so that you feel comfortable speaking in front of the camera.
- **Be specific with your answers,** be sure to carefully address every component of the questions.
- **Start with a quick introduction:** your name, where you live, where you completed your bachelor's degree and your major. Then you can begin addressing the questions.
- **Treat the video submission like an interview,** be professional but also be yourself, we want to see who you are and experience your personality.
- Faculty reviewing your application want to know why our program is appealing to you and in what way it will help you reach your future career goals. **Be as specific as possible.**
- **Test the lighting and sound,** you may need to make some adjustments prior to recording.
- **Frame yourself well** in the video. Prop your computer up so it is level with your upper body.
